# **INDIVIDUAL VAM**

- <sup>2</sup> FCAT Teachers
- <sup>2</sup> Non-FCAT Teachers
- <sup>2</sup> Algebra EOC Teachers
- <sup>2</sup> Third Grade Teachers
  - <sup>2</sup> 50% Student Performance Data = School VAM

<sup>2</sup> 50% FCAT Reading Developmental Scale Score average compared to previous year school average

# **INDIVIDUAL VAM**

- N = 2
- Adjust score if not current year individual data
  - Weight previous year individual score with school VAM score
- Scale 40% and 50% points separately

# SCHOOL VAM

- <sup>2</sup> Pre K, Kindergarten, First Grade, Second Grade Teachers
- <sup>2</sup> School wide instructional positions
  - <sup>2</sup> Examples: Guidance Counselors, Behavior Specialists
- <sup>2</sup> Junior and Senior Teachers
  - <sup>2</sup> Including IB and AP Teachers

### SCHOOL VAM

• Scale school wide VAM scores to minimize the impact of outliers

- Scale points from 5 to 40 or 5 to 50
  - Lowest score = 5 (versus 0)

### **District VAM**

- <sup>2</sup> Hospital Homebound<sup>2</sup> Private School ESE
- Median of school VAM scores

### **Additional Recommendations**

#### Extended Transition Teachers

• Apply same process as Adult Ed Teachers

#### • Florida Alternative Assessment (FAA)

- Apply same process as used 2011-2012 for Center schools
- Include self-contained K-12 site based teachers

### **Summative Score**
