WHEREAS, Pinellas County has 587 miles of Coastline and over 65,000 private swimming pools; *and*

WHEREAS, according to the USA Swimming Foundation, drowning is the second leading cause of childhood accidental death; *and*

WHEREAS, 40% of Caucasian, 60% of Hispanic, and 70% of African-American children have low or no swimming ability; *and*

WHEREAS, participation in formal swimming lessons could reduce the likelihood of childhood drowning by 88%; *and*

WHEREAS, the School Board of Pinellas County wishes to support programs that increase awareness, provide education, and training relating to child water safety;
