SECOND AMENDMENT TO CHARTER SCHOOL AGREEMENT – RENEWAL

This Second Amendment to Charter School Agreement – Renewal ("Amendment") is made by and between Academie Da Vinci Charter School, Inc., a nonprofit organization ("School"), which is operating the Academie DaVinci Charter School in Pinellas County, and The School Board of Pinellas County, Florida ("School Board"), this 9th day of April, 2013, and provides as follows:

WHEREAS, School Board approved School's Charter School Agreement - Renewal on March 25, 2011 ("Charter"), which provides sponsorship for School's charter school serving grades K-5;

WHEREAS, School has requested to amend the Charter to increase the maximum enrollment from 238 to 250 student; and

WHEREAS, School Board desires to amend the Charter to allow the requested increase in the maximum enrollment.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The first sentence of paragraph 2.10 of the Charter is amended to read: "The School shall serve the following grade levels and total number of students: grade levels K-5; total number of students 250."
- 2. All terms and conditions of the Charter, except as specifically amended herein, shall continue will full force and effect.
