

**First Amendment to Agreement between  
The School Board of Pinellas County, Florida and  
St. Petersburg College Regarding  
The Campbell Park Reading Initiative**

This First Amendment to Agreement is entered into this 7th day of May, 2013, by and between The School Board of Pinellas County, Florida (hereinafter "School Board"), and St. Petersburg College (hereinafter "SPC").

WHEREAS, on January 29, 2013, the School Board approved an Agreement whereby School Board and SPC would collaborate to increase literacy rates among Pinellas County students struggling in reading by providing opportunities for SPC College of Education students to tutor struggling students on the Campbell Park Elementary School campus;

WHEREAS, the original term of this Agreement was from January 29, 2013, through May 10, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend this Agreement through June 30, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and the following terms, the parties agree as follows:

1. Section 2 ("Term of Project") of the Agreement is amended to state as follows:
  2. Term of Project: This project shall begin upon execution of this Agreement by both parties and expire on June 30, 2015. The parties reserve the right to extend this Agreement for a specified period of time by written amendment signed by both parties.
2. All terms and condition of the Agreement, except as specifically amended herein, shall continue with full force and effect.
