Strategic Direction(s): Student Achievement

Program Description: This amendment for contract LC915 with the Florida Department of Children and Families for the school district's Child Care Worker Training Program increases the contract for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to \$148,380.04. The amendment updates the Contract Manager Information, replaces Attachment III, adds Special Provisions for Employment Eligibility Verification (E-Verify) and revised liability language. This amendment also includes allowing for the utilization of air cards at exams and courses with no extra cost to the provider.

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Rationale: Funding currently received from training program includes state funds plus 60% of the fees collected for on line training courses. The \$6,340 increase is due to a loss in revenue from a malfunction of the Department of Children and Families website prohibiting student's from paying for online courses. The amendment for the air cards is due to an error in wording that limits where the cards could be used. This adjustment will allow for more flexibility and will allow the district to reach more students. The change of forms are required to keep the Department of Children and Families current with the demands of policy.
