Strategic Direction(s): Student Achievement

Program Description: Categorical state funds are allocated by the Florida Legislature to fund the Adults with Disabilities (AWD) program. Grant funds will allow Pinellas County Schools to continue to serve approximately 200 adults with disabilities at UPARC and 3 Life Skills sites. The overall objective of the Program for Adults with Disabilities is to provide adults with moderate to severe disabilities opportunities to acquire skills that will lead to greater self-sufficiency. Lifelong learning classes will focus on teaching self-care and independent living skills. Workforce preparation classes will focus on teaching skills necessary to move to supported employment or sheltered workshop employment.

Rationale: Adults with disabilities face waiting lists and Medicaid waiver funding approval to enroll into local agency programs. The waiting lists for these local agencies vary in length of time from six months to four years. The AWD program provides training in the areas of independent living, workplace readiness and literacy skills for approximately 200 developmentally disabled adults who do not have any other day program option in Pinellas.
