Students to be served/Target Audience: 180 students, grades 3-5, attending three DA status elementary schools.

Performance Data, Research Findings, or Improvement Results: Students who participate in 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant programs have better class grades, increased math and reading proficiency on standardized test, higher rates of homework completion, greater class participation, and improved student behavior (*Learning Point Associates, 2010*). A study of about 3,000

low-income, ethnically-diverse elementary and middle school students found that those who regularly attended high-quality programs over two years demonstrated gains of up to 20 percentile points in reading and 12 percentile points in standardized math test scores respectively, compared to peers who were routinely unsupervised during the afterschool hours (*Policy Studies Associates, Inc., 2007*).
